

## Age-Friendly Community



is an inclusive and accessible environment that promotes active aging, emphasizes enablement rather than disablement, is friendly for all ages and abilities.

#### **Mobility Options and Older Adults**

- Cars and other private motorized vehicles are the predominant mode of travel for people ages 50 and older
- Walking accounts for more than threefourths of all trips not made by personal vehicle among persons age 50 and older
- People using a combination of transportation modes have higher levels of mobility and better health outcomes
- 50+ who don't drive have significantly lower levels of outside interaction than drivers 50+
- Over 50% report they could not continue living in their current neighborhood if they could no longer drive



# **Beyond Driving: Growing Need for Mobility Options**

- A man who is 70 today is likely to outlive his driving years by about 7 years
- A woman who is 70 today is likely to outlive her driving years by about 11 years.
- 4.5 million non-drivers older than age 75 today and by 2020 it is projected to grow to 6 million










### Getting there
